Membership

EICC membership is open to electronic manufacturers, software firms, ICT firms, and manufacturing service providers, including contracted labor, that design, market, manufacture and/or provide electronic goods or other materials or services to ICT firms. Qualified applicants may become EICC members upon a majority vote of the EICC Board of Directors. Member Companies not a part of the supply chain for two years will not be eligible to maintain membership status.

Levels of Membership:

APPLICANT MEMBER: Confers the privilege to use EICC tools, participate in meetings and workgroups, and other privileges consistent with these Bylaws as the Board of Directors may from time to time confer. Member is subject to applicant membership requirements as outlined in Membership Compliance Program. A member company may remain an Applicant Member no longer than two years. At the end of two years, the member company is required to become a Full Member. At any point during these two years, an Applicant Member may choose to be evaluated for Full Membership by submitting a formal request to Board.

FULL MEMBER: Confers the privilege to vote on matters to be voted on by the membership; allows eligibility for Board position or workgroup leadership, use of all EICC tools, and participation in meetings and workgroups; and allows other privileges consistent with these Bylaws as the Board of Directors may from time to time confer. Member is subject to full membership requirements as outlined in Membership Compliance Program.

Annual Dues

Annual dues are based on the company's current annual revenue and projected membership level for the current year. Dues are payable within 60 days from the invoice date; if dues are not received in this timeframe official membership will be deferred.

Subsidiaries and Affiliates

A member and its Affiliates/Subsidiaries shall be deemed one member. An Affiliate is defined as any legal entity that directly or indirectly controls, is controlled by, or is under common control with another entity via beneficial ownership of more than 50% of voting power or equity in another entity.

Requirements

APPLICANT MEMBER:

- Complete membership application, submit to Administrator
- Provide a commitment letter signed by a senior executive of the company agreeing to support the EICC's vision, mission, and bylaws/operating principles; membership requirements. Letter must be included in membership application.
- Publicly acknowledge the company's inclusion in the EICC, within 30 days of membership acceptance. This can be via the company website, company report, and/or a press release.
- Pay dues within 60 days of membership acceptance and initial formal invoicing .
- Submit a completed and scored corporate-level SAQ within 90 days of membership acceptance.

FULL MEMBER:

- Meet all Applicant member requirements.
- Adopt the Code of Conduct.
- Demonstrate progress toward conformance to the Code for member facilities as defined in Membership Compliance Program.
- Ensure adoption of the Code by major suppliers.

Administrative Requirements (applicable to Applicant and Full Members)

- Pay annual dues in full by the published due date as defined by Section 6 of the EICC Bylaws, 60 days from invoice date.
- Actively participate in the EICC.
- Provide requested data per published timeline for EICC reports, including but not limited to the Annual Report.
- Read and understand by-laws and membership requirements.
